- Read, recognise and write numbers to 20
- Add two numbers to the value of 10 and more
- Recognise 2D and 3D shapes and their properties
- Sequence shapes and objects
- Order objects according to size
- Use nonstandard measure to measure weight and length
- Understand and give directions
- Learn about money and pay for items using 1p, 2p, 5p, and 10p coins
- Count in twos (beginning to recognise odd and even numbers)

In English your child will:

- Revise all letter sounds and learn new sounds which include r h b f ff l ll ss j v w x y z zzquchsh
- Continue to read their home / school book and progress with their spelling logs and recognise a growing number of keywords
- Write simple short sentences independently
- Use imagination to create their own stories
- Write in different formats such as lists, diaries, stories, letters, labelling .
