

In Maths your child will:

- Recognise all coins and know coin equivalence. Find totals, and work out which coins to pay from up to £.
- Uses decimal notation when recording money
- Understand and use £.p notation. Know note and coin equivalence. Find totals, give change and work out which coins, notes to pay
- Order the months of the year.
- Use units of time and know the relationships between them (day, week, month, year.)
- Read the time to the hour, half hour or quarter hour on an analogue/digital clock.
- Make whole, half and quarter turns, to the left, right, clockwise or anti-clockwise.
- To solve problems involving time.
- Say the number that is 1 or 10 more or less than any given two-digit number.
- Say the number that is 1, 10 or 100 more or less than any two or three digit number.
- Use the mathematical names for common 2-D; sort shapes and describe some of their features

In English your child will:

- Take part in group reading sessions on a weekly basis ensuring key words are read correctly and punctuation is beginning to be used. Ensure children are reading fluently with expression.
- Learn key word spelling and practice them at home using their spelling logs.
- Use Floppy's Phonics in order to learn unfamiliar phonic sounds.
- Ensure capital letters and full stops are being used correctly. Introduce question marks, speech marks and commas.
- Study the book 'Traction Man is Here' and discuss characters, setting, re-tell the story, create a story map, re-write the story and change the characters in order to create their very own story.
- To research and read about forests.
