Use multiplication facts from the 2s to 12s times tables and find corresponding division facts to solve problems.

Area, Perimeter, lines of symmetry.

Fractions and percentages $\frac{1}{2} = 50\%$ $\frac{1}{4} = 25\%$ $\frac{3}{4} = 75\%$

Numbers to 1000- ordering and sequencing.

Adding and subtracting 10 and 100.

Rounding numbers to nearest 10 and 100.

Negative numbers in the context of temperature.

To create an information text based on their learning from their topic 'the Romans'.
