

In Maths your child will:

- Divide 2 digit numbers by a 1 digit number.
- Use the short form method of division with remainders
- Calculate fractions of amounts.
- Understand decimals to one place.
- Order whole and negative numbers on a number line.
- Practical weight activities linked to Tudor biscuits.
- Time - Analogue o'clock, 1/4 past, half past, quarter to, 5 minute intervals and digital time.
- Use money to pay for items up to £10. Calculate change
- Learn off by heart the 2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9, and 10 X tables.

In English your child will:

- Take part in a group guided reading session on a weekly basis.
- Participate in a Football Literacy Project linked to Wrexham Racecourse Ground. (Pupils will require outdoor PE kit.)
- Focus on Haiku poems linked to Wales
- Focus on Cinquain poetry
- Produce factual writing on Saint David's Day
- Discursive writing
- Develop literacy skills in Forest Schools sessions.
